


Problem Statement

- Patch them all!
- Scan > Prioritize > Assess > Report > Fix > Verify

Reducing Attack Surface

- Unify environment landscape
- Customize server build
 - Do not start services your are not using
 - Privilage account management
 - Multi-factor authentification
 - Do not use default ports



Be ready for Day Zero Vulnerability

- Firewall
- Whitelisting software
- Segmentation: HW, Network
- Do not mess with strangers (USB)
- Intrusion detection system




Corporate Global Challenges
